Cartagena: Punic, Medieval & Neoclassical Defensive Architecture Tour

- * Walking tour starting from Cartagena at the Town Hall Square. Lasting time: 4 hours.
- * It includes a visit to the Naval Museum & Peral's Submarine.
- * Catamaran tickets (5£ pax).
- * Guide fees: 10 €per person (minimum 100€ maximum 150)

Admire the Ancient Walls, Castles, Coastal Defenses and 18th c. Military Architecture, visit the Naval Museum and enjoy an exciting Catamaran tour of the bay.

The military historical heritage of Cartagena is certainly impressive. Walls from different periods, from the original Punic Rampart (227 BC) to the Sea Wall (18th century). The entrance to the natural port of Cartagena is guarded by a series of castles and coastal batteries dating from the 18th and 19th centuries that, in their day, made the city virtually impregnable. On the different hills which surround the city port we can admire four 18th c. fortresses, apart from the Muslim Medieval Castle of Conception on the central hill facing the bay. And furthermore, the Military Arsenal, the Neoclassical Military Hospital, Admiralty Palace, Royal House, Artillery Park and many others. Difficult to find so much military heritage in a city. And also a wonderful Naval Museum which houses some of the most interesting artifacts of the Spanish Navy, an Artillery Museum and the jewel of all this legacy: the first modern submarine, the 1884 original Isaac Peral's craft. Enjoy with us this visit which also includes a Catamaran tour along the port and out of the bay so as to admire the hidden coastal batteries, the Fort of Navidad and enjoy the stories about the pirates that infested the coast from Medieval times till 18th century.
